**LOCATION:** The Brown County 4-H Fairgrounds, 802 Memorial Drive, Nashville, Indiana. Located about 1/4 mile east of downtown Nashville at Main Street and Memorial Drive.

**SETUP**: Go to the Club table in the North (smaller) pavilion to check in and get your booth location. Booths will be assigned. For Indoor booths there are electrical outlets available. No electricity is available for outdoor vendors. WIFI will need to be acquired by the vendor. The Indoor show area will be in the two open-air roofed green buildings and the Outdoor booths are in the grassy area on the south side of the buildings.

**FACILITIES:** The Rock & Mineral Show will be held at the Brown County 4-H Fairgrounds. Demonstrations are welcome and encouraged. A food truck will be available. Parking is free. Handicap parking is in front of the building on the east side next to the street. Bathroom facilities are inside the building using the south double doors. Since September is at the height of Brown County tourist season, it is advisable that you make reservations well in advance for overnight accommodations in/near Nashville. We have permission from Fair Board that you may stay overnight in your automobile, but no electricity is available, no fires are allowed, and no alcohol is permitted on the premises.
